433 children ages 0-16 served in the **EMERGENCY SHELTER**

- \checkmark Average length of stay is 27 days
- ✓ 99% served maintained or showed improvement in developmental milestones
- \checkmark 51% were discharged to a foster home

60 children ages 5-12 served in the RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT CENTER

- ✓ Average length of stay is 295 days
- ✓ 100% of children remained safe while in our care
- ✓ 71% served maintained or showed improvement in developmental milestones
- \checkmark 34% were discharged to a family setting

Family of Services: Fostering the Future



291children ages 0-18 served in FOSTER HOME CARE

- ✓ 99% served maintained or showed improvement in developmental milestones
- ✓ 100% served maintained or improved mental health functioning
- ✓ 58% of children placed were four years or younger
- ✓ 39% were moved to a permanent placement

450 fathers and 1,172 children in COMPADRE Y COMPADRE®

- ✓ 100% of fathers had no further cps investigations after enrolling
- ✓ 100% of fathers committed to nonviolent parenting approaches
- ✓ 97% of fathers improved in positive parenting and child rearing attitudes
- ✓ 50% of graduates continued as mentors after completing the 15-week program
